1. Purpose/Report Summary

The purpose of this staff report is to present to the Board a request made by Fronteer Development Group Inc. (the Company) for a one year storage authorization for their land use permit, MV2002C0008.

Currently the materials remaining on site include: 5 wooden structures on site (kitchen, dry, logging shack, storage shack, and outhouse) and several tent floors for sleeping tents.

2. Background

- Applied for the LUP March 21, 2002
- Original LUP issued June 26, 2002 and expired June 25, 2007
- Assignment request received January 30, 2004
- Assignment approved and signed April 30, 2004
- Sent Final Plan letter to the company on March 9, June 22, and July 30 of 2007 with no response from the company, I tried phoning the company but was told the contact person was out of office traveling or was out on holiday.
- Storage Authorization received on December 17, 2007

4. Discussion

As mentioned already the company has the remaining items mentioned above left on site and will begin removing and cleaning up the camp in the spring of 2008, they have already started the process by removing the fuel drums in May and June of 2006. The company has indicated in the e-mail that a final plan will be forthcoming as soon as they are able and will begin the process of removing the camp as soon as weather permits them to start.

5. Comments

INAC inspector Clint Ambrose had contacted Ian Cunningham-Dunlop via e-mail letting the company know that their LUP had expired and they should submit their final plan to our WLWB office as well as a final cleanup and restoration of the permit area. Inspector Clint Ambrose suggested that the company apply for a storage authorization to finalize the closure to the permit and providing the company steps to follow leading to the company's final conclusion to the LUP.

6. Review comments

The Tlicho Government did not submit comments (project is not on Tlicho lands).

In the e-mail correspondence to Fronteer the inspector states INAC's concerns and the process of completing a final clean up with regards to keeping the WLWB and INAC Inspector Clint Ambrose informed of the proceedings, and to give notice when the company has finalized the completion of clean up to the permitted area.

6. Security

There is no security deposit associated with the LUP

7. Conclusion

There appears to be no concerns for approval to the storage authorization.

8. Recommendation

I recommend that the storage authorization be approved for a period of one year.
