These comments are submitted from the Environmental Health Office with the Stanton Territorial Health Authority regarding the above Land Use Application.

Application indicates that potable water will be obtained from Indin Lake. Please ensure that the water is disinfected prior to human consumption. The easiest way is batch chlorination. Other options, such as UV filtration, are also available.

Also, we would like to see all sewage sumps located at least 30 meters away from any buildings and water bodies. Hydrated lime should be applied on a regular bases to reduce odour problems and to facilitate biodegradation process. Proposed methods for solid waste disposal are acceptable.
