We have corrected the file number to G07E006, to better reflect the land use operation you applied for, namely operation, maintenance and reconstruction activities along the Dempster Highway, including quarry operation at the specified locations. CONDITIONS ANNEXED TO AND FORMING PART OF LAND USE PERMIT: G07E006

PART A: SCOPE OF LAND USE PERMIT

1. This Land Use Permit entitles the **Department of Transportation – Government of the Northwest Territories** to conduct the following activities:

Highway Operation, Maintenance and Reconstruction, including Quarry Operation. NWT Highway #8 (Dempster Highway) and quarry sites located at kilometres 6.3, 24, 28.9, 141, 166.4, 178.2, 193.7, 211.2, 230.2, 235.3 and 251.2
2. This Land Use Permit is issued subject to the conditions contained herein with respect to the use of land for the activities and area identified in Part A, Item 1 of this Land Use Permit.
3. Compliance with the terms and conditions of this Land Use Permit does not absolve the Permittee from responsibility for compliance with the requirements of all applicable Federal, Territorial and Municipal legislation.

PART B: DEFINITIONS

"Act" means the Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act.

"Board" means the Gwich'in Land and Water Board established under Part 3 of the Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act.

"Land Use Inspector" means an Inspector designated by the Minister under the Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act.
