| 1.2 | The Permittee shall not conduct any part of the land use operation within three hundred (300) metres of any privately owned land or structure, unless otherwise authorized in writing by the BOARD. | PRIVATE

| 1.3 | The Permittee shall remove from Gwich'in Lands, all scrap metal, discarded machinery and parts, barrels and kegs, buildings and building material. | REMOVE

26 (1) (b) - TIMES OF THE LAND USE OPERATION

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| 2.1 | The Permittee's Field Supervisor shall contact or meet with a LAND USE INSPECTOR at the office of the Department of Indian and Northern Development, telephone number (867) 777-3361, at least forty-eight (48) hours before the commencement of this land use operation. | CONTACT

| 2.2 | The Permittee shall advise the BOARD at least ten (10) days prior to the completion of the land use operation of (a) his plan for removal or storage of equipment and materials, and (b) when final clean-up and and restoration of the land used will be completed. | REPORTS

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| 8.1 | The Permittee shall not unnecessarily damage wildlife habitat in conducting this land use operation. | HABITAT DAMAGE |
| 8.2 | The deposition of deleterious substances in to water bodies frequented by fish is prohibited under Section 36 of the Fisheries Act . The proponent should ensure that any chemicals, fuels, or waste associated with the proposed project do not enter in such waters. | PROHIBITED ACTIVITY |

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| 11.2 | The Permittee shall not place any petroleum fuel storage containers within thirty (30) metres of the normal high water mark of any stream or the Mackenzie River. | FUEL BY

| 11.3 | The Permittee shall not allow petroleum products to spread to surrounding lands or into water bodies by having absorbing pads on site during fuel transfer from drums to equipment. | FUEL
CONTAINMENT |
| 11.4 | The Permittee shall mark all fuel containers with the Permittee's name. This includes 45 gallon drums. | MARK
