1: Scope

1.1 This Licence entitles the Rat River Development Corporation to deposit up to a maximum of **500** cubic metres of granular material (rip-rap) below the ordinary high water mark at the Tl'oondih Healing Camp located on the east shore of the Peel River south of Fort McPherson in the Northwest Territories for the purpose of controlling shore erosion.

1.2 Whenever new Regulations are made, or existing Regulations are amended by the Federal Minister under the *Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act*, or any other statutes imposing more stringent conditions, this Licence shall be deemed to be automatically amended to conform with such Regulations upon such Regulations coming into effect; and

1.3 Compliance with the terms and conditions of this Licence does not absolve the Licencee from complying with the requirements of other Federal, Territorial or Municipal legislation.

2: Definitions

2.1 In this Licence:

"Act" shall mean the *Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act*;

"Board" shall mean the Gwich'in Land and Water Board established under Section 54(1) of the *Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act*;

"Granular Material" shall mean, in this case; rip-rap;

"Inspector" shall mean an Inspector designated by the Minister under Section 35(1) of the *Northwest Territories Waters Act*;

"Licencee" shall mean the holder of this Licence, in this case; the Rat River Development Corporation;

"Regulations" shall mean the Regulations proclaimed pursuant to Section 29 of the *Northwest Territories Waters Act*;

"River" shall mean the Peel River;

"Waste" shall mean waste as defined by Section 2 of the *Northwest Territories Waters Act*; and

"Water Licence Application" shall mean the application prepared by the Licencee and supporting drawings and documentation.

3: Conditions

3.1 The Licencee is authorized to deposit up to a maximum of **500** cubic metres of granular material (rip-rap) below the ordinary high water mark at the Tl'oondih Healing Camp located on the east shore of the Peel River south of Fort McPherson in the Northwest Territories for the purpose of controlling shore erosion.

3.2 The Licencee shall ensure that the size of the granular material (rip-rap) used in this undertaking range is no less than .25 cubic metres and is free of contaminants and fines.

3.3 The Licencee shall ensure that, other than the despost of the rip-rap, there is no other disturbance to the bank of the river.

3.4 The Licencee shall ensure that no material is left on the ice after the completion of this undertaking.

3.5 The Licencee shall ensure that no fuels or wastes will be used in this undertaking.

3.6 The Licencee shall ensure that any spills of toxic materials used in this undertaking are immediately reported to the Inspector via the 24 Hour Spill Report Line ((867) 920-8130) and that a detailed report of each event is submitted to the Inspector within thirty (30) days of the spill being detected.

3.7 The Licencee shall file a report for this undertaking with the Board no later than June 29th, 2007, which shall contain the following information:

- a) quantities of granular material (rip-rap) deposited and removed;
- b) the number and type of equipment used;
- c) the start date and the date of completion;
- d) any pictures of the area before, during or after the undertaking.
