1.0 26 (1) (A) - LOCATION AND AREA

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| 1.1 | The Permittee shall not conduct this land use operation on any lands not designated in the accepted application, unless otherwise authorized in writing by the Board. | PLANS |
| 1.2 | The Permittee shall not conduct any part of the land use operation within 300 metres of any privately owned land or structure unless otherwise authorized in writing by the Board. | PRIVATE PROPERTY |
| 1.9 | The Permittee shall at all times conform to all applicable Federal, Territorial or local regulations, ordinances or bylaws. | CONFORM TO APPLICABLE LAWS |

2.0 26 (1) (B) - TIME

| 2.11 | The Permittee shall remove all snow fills from stream crossings prior to spring break-up or completion of the land use operation unless otherwise approved in writing by a Land Use Inspector. | REMOVE SNOW FILLS |

3.0 26 (1) (C) - EQUIPMENT

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| 3.1 | The Permittee shall not use any equipment except of the type, size, and number that is listed in the accepted application, unless otherwise authorized in writing by the Land Use Inspector. | ONLY APPROVED EQUIPMENT |
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5.0 26(1)E) - TYPE, LOCATION, CAPACITY AND/OPERATION OF FACILITIES

5.7 The Permittee shall ensure that the land use area is kept clean and tidy at all times. **CLEAN WORK AREA**

6.0 26 (1) (F) - CONTROL OR PREVENTION OF FLOODING, EROSION AND SUBSIDENCE OF LAND

6.0 The Permittee shall not use any material other than water and or clean snow in the construction of ice bridges, ramps and snow fills. **ICE BRIDGE MATERIAL**

6.1 The Permittee shall not allow any ice bridge to hinder the flow of water in any stream. **NATURAL DRAINAGE**

6.2 The Permittee shall remove any obstruction to natural drainage caused by any part of this land use operation. **NATURAL DRAINAGE**

6.17 The Permittee shall not move any equipment or vehicles unless the ground surface is in a state capable of fully supporting the equipment or vehicles without rutting or gouging. **VEHICLES MOVEMENT FREEZE-UP**

26 (1) (g) - USE, STORAGE, HANDLING AND DISPOSAL, OF CHEMICAL OR TOXIC MATERIAL

7.1 The Permittee shall remove all garbage and debris from the area of the land use operation to a disposal site approved as directed by a Land Use Inspector. **REMOVE GARBAGE**

7.3 The Permittee shall report all spills immediately in accordance with instructions contained in "Spill Report" form N.W.T.1086 (10/79). 24 hour Spill Report Line (403) 920-8130. **REPORT CHEMICAL AND PETROLEUM SPILLS**

8.0 26 (1) (H) - WILDLIFE AND FISHERIES HABITAT

8.1 The Permittee shall not unnecessarily damage wildlife habitat in conducting this land use operation. **HABITAT DAMAGE**

8.12 The Permittee shall not in any circumstances deposit or allow the deposit of any deleterious substances (including but not limited to fuels, lubricants, Hydraulics and coolants) of any type into any waters, or in any place under any conditions where the deleterious substances may enter any waters. **DEPOSITING DELETERIOUS SUBSTANCES**

10.0 26 (I) (J) - HISTORICAL / ARCHAEOLOGICAL SITES

10.1 The permittee shall not operate any vehicle within five hundred(500) metres of a known or suspected archaeological site. **VEHICLE OPERATION**

10.2 The Permittee shall not remove, disturb or displace any archaeological specimen or site. **DISTURB OR DISPLACE**

10.3 The Permittee shall contact the Board and the PWNHC should an archaeological site or specimen be encountered by any land use activity

CONTACTS

10.4 The permittee shall immediately cease any activity that disturbs an archaeological or historical site, encountered during the course of a land use operation; until permitted to proceed with the authorization of the Board.

11.4 The Permittee shall not feed wildlife.

13.2 The Permittee shall not place any petroleum fuel storage containers within thirty (30) metres of the normal high water mark of any stream.

15.2 The Permittee shall complete all clean-up and restoration of the lands used prior to the expiry date of this permit.
