Project Description

The proposed activity is for fuel storage at the James Creek Highway Maintenance Camp at km 14 on the Dempster Highway. There will be two containers of diesel fuel stored. The capacity of the containers is 101,067 and 21,800 litres. Fuel will be stored throughout the year at this location. The period of operation will be from April 1, 1999 to March 31, 2004.

The fuel is required for maintenance work on the Dempster Highway. A containment fuel spill contingency plan is in place for this operation. The plan includes the use of pumps and empty barrels for storage, oil absorbent pads, and a 3 feet high concrete berm to contain potential spills.
