I think the main thing to take into account is whether or not de-icing is occurring at the airport. Once de-icing is in progress the samples can be taken. I would suggest that sampling should occur some time after de-icing occurs but before freeze up. Please let me know when you plan to take the samples. If you have any questions please contact me.

We have a question regarding part B, item 4, of the Surveillance Network Program for the above mentioned licence. For stations L1 through L5, it is required to sample for glycol and COD in the spring and fall. In the past, the fall sampling has been taken to mean December for some reason.
