**RE: Authorization to Discharge Glycol Retention Facility (GRF) and Glycol Retention and Treatment Facility (GRTF) and Denial of NT Spill 10-099 Closure.**

Dear Mr. Stroman,

The Inspector has reviewed the water quality results submitted on August 18<sup>th</sup>, 2010 for the treated glycol impacted waters currently stored on site in the GRF and GRTF. All results were within the criteria prescribed by Water Licence MV2001L8-0012. This letter is to serve as authorization to discharge those waters in the manner prescribed by the aforementioned Water Licence.

The Department of Transportation has also requested the closure of NT Spill 10-099. At this time the Inspector will not be removing any monitoring requirements or recommending closure of the spill until after fall precipitation to ensure clean up. The sampling will take place during the Water Licence inspection.

This inspection will take place during active deicing as to also allow DOT the opportunity to demonstrate that their new deicing procedures are mitigating the potential release of Glycol into the receiving environment to the satisfaction of the Inspector.
