1. Purpose/Report Summary

To notify the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board that the Hamlet of Enterprise (Enterprise) has submitted the required Interim Closure and Reclamation Plan (Plan) as required in the Water Licence (WL).

2. Background

- August 27, 2009 – WL issued;
- May 27, 2010 – Study received;
- June 2, 2010 – sent to reviewers;
- June 30, 2010 – comments due;
- July 5, 2010 - comments sent to Enterprise;
- July 29, 2010 - Plan resubmitted addressing concerns; and
- August 19, 2010 - presented to the Board.

3. Discussion

Part G Item 2 of the WL states that:

The Licensee shall address the following when completing or revising the Abandonment and Restoration Plan:

- Waste disposal sites and facilities;
- The petroleum and chemical storage areas;
- Any site affected by Waste spills;
- The natural runoff Waters from the development site;
- The restoration of natural drainage and the restoration of stream banks at the operation site(s);
- The potential for groundwater contamination;

- Any facilities or areas which may have been affected by development such that potential pollution problems exist;
- A phased approach and implementation schedule;
- Maps delineating all disturbed areas, borrow material locations, and site facilities;
- Identify testing and disposal of any collected leachate from the solid Waste facility; and
- A proposal identifying measures by which restoration costs will be financed by the Licensee upon abandonment.

The final Abandonment and Restoration Plan as Per Part G Item 9 will be submitted to the Board 6 months prior to the final abandonment of any of the sites.


