Incomplete Application - Road Access and Camp, Matthews Lake

The Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board (MVLWB or the Board) received your application for Land Use Permit MV2009X0028 on July 24, 2009. MVLWB staff has determined that there is insufficient information to conduct a preliminary screening in accordance with paragraph 22(1)(a) of the Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations (MVLUR). Please submit the following information so MVLWB staff can consider the application complete and forward it for review:

1. A community involvement log which includes detailed minutes of all meetings held and all other correspondence with the following communities, Aboriginal groups, and First Nations;
 - a. Akaitcho Interim Measures Agreement Implementation Office, contact: Stephen Ellis, (867) 370-3217
 - b. North Slave Metis Alliance, Sheryl Grieve, (867) 873-6762
 - c. Tlicho Lands Protection Department, Director, (867) 392-6389

Details of the meetings should include:

- When contact was first initiated, this should be within the last year;
- The nature, dates, and locations of meetings held;
- A list of groups represented at the meetings;
- A list of the issues raised by the stakeholders; and
- An indication of how the issues were addressed in the application.

If you are unable to contact and meet with any of these communities, Aboriginal groups, or First Nations, please provide the reason(s) why the meeting could not be held. Provide a listing, including the dates, of any phone calls or other means that may have been used to provide information about the project and to hear any interests or concerns of Akaitcho First Nations with respect to your development;


2. Spill response plan. The plan included in the application should be relevant to the area and include the field emergency response plan mentioned above. Emergency numbers and instructions should be current (i.e. local numbers for emergency). Please refer to the Indian and Northern Affairs Canada "Guidelines for Spill Contingency Planning" (April 2007). This document is available at <http://www.ainc-inac.gc.ca/> under "Environment and Natural Resources", "Publications".
3. A detailed summary of the camp that is to be permitted, including the amount of water used at the camp and the source of withdrawal.

Upon receipt of this information, MVLWB staff will process the application and the review period will begin. If you need further clarification, please contact me at (867) 669-0506 or email permits@mvlwb.com.

If you do not provide the requested supplementary information within 90 days, the MVLWB will assume that you do not wish to continue with this application. The Board will then return the application to you as per section 25 of the MVLUR. Indian and Northern Affairs Canada will refund any land use fees you have submitted in conjunction with this application.
