1. Purpose/Report Summary

The purpose of this staff report is to present to the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board (the Board) a request to close Land Use Permit (LUP) application MV2009X0028 submitted by Bathurst Inlet Developments (1984) Ltd.

2. Background

- July 24, 2009 – LUP application received;
- July 30, 2009 – LUP application deemed incomplete;
- August 5, 2009 – June 2, 2010 – additional information received;
- June 3, 2010 – LUP application deemed complete and sent for review;
- June 25, 2010 – review comments due;
- July 8, 2010 – presented to the Board and decision made to send application for further information under s. 22(2)(b) of the MVLUR and confirm that the application is exempt from preliminary screening;
- July 15, 2010 – response to review comments received from Applicant;
- July 28, 2010 – request for more specific responses to reviewer concerns;
- August 3, 2010 – request from Applicant to withdraw the Land Use Permit application; and
- August 19, 2010 – closure request presented to the Board.

It has been requested that this LUP application be withdrawn (see attached). Note that there is a storage authorization in place for MV2001X0030 (the previous permit for this area) until July of 2011.
