This is the information that was requested on the letter dated May 4, 2010.

1. A valid quarry permit from INAC: There was a quarrying permit application sent to INAC on April 23 for 1000 cubic meters of sand, we received a reply back on May 5 stating that the application had been sent to the appropriate First Nations with a comment due date of June 3, 2010. Once the approved application is received I will forward it on to you.
2. Clarification on fuel storage on site: The only fuel that will be on site at any time will be held in the jockey tanks in the pickups, these tanks hold anywhere from 300 litres to 450 litres of fuel. The purpose of the fuel is to refuel the equipment. There will not be any fuel actually stored on the site as the pickups will be returned to Carter Industries at the end of each day.
3. Follow up information in the community involvement log: The follow up log is attached.
