

Akaiicho Dene First Nations - Community involvement for Land Use Permit and Water License Applications

Under the Mackenzie Valley Land Water Board's (MVLWB) 'Guidelines for Public Involvement for Permit and License Applicants to the MVLWB', proponents are required to inform communities about their proposed projects prior to submitting their application.

For proponents applying for Land Use Permits and Water Licenses within the area of the Akaiicho Dene First Nations (AKFNs), proponents should first contact the Akaiicho Interim Measures Agreement Implementation Office. The IMA office will assist proponents in their community involvement efforts to ensure that they are contacting and meeting with the appropriate AKFNs.

It is important that proponents meet face to face with AKFNs prior to submission of an application and provide details of these meetings in applications submitted to the MVLWB as outlined in the Guidelines for Public Involvement.
